Today - Scattered thunderstorms are expected to develop across Massachusetts this afternoon, while activity over central Connecticut should remain in the form of isolated pop-up showers and thunderstorms. Anticipate that towards the conclusion of the first round there will be a few vicinity thunderstorms some 15-20+ miles north of the course as afternoon thunderstorms over Massachusetts slowly drift south-southeastward. Otherwise expect partly cloudy to mixed skies with a high temperature of $93^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ and a heat index peaking around $100^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.

Extended forecast - A few showers and isolated thunderstorms are possible overnight into Friday morning, with thunderstorms becoming more numerous after 12pm Friday as a cold front drops in from the north. Activity is expected to become isolated by $8-9 \mathrm{pm}$ Friday evening. Daily rainfall of $0.50^{\prime \prime}-1.00 \prime$ is forecast, but locally higher totals of 1-2" are possible as several cells are expected to produce prolific rainfall rates. The heat index will top out in the mid-90s on Friday. Mostly cloudy on Saturday with a low coverage of showers and thunderstorms in the morning increasing to a scattered coverage by the early afternoon. Sunday will see continued chances for showers and thunderstorms out ahead of a cold front set to move through the region on Monday. Southerly winds of $10-15 \mathrm{mph}$ will gust to 20 mph after 12 pm Sunday.
