

SIGNATURE EVENT FACT SHEET (ENTERING VALERO TEXAS OPEN)

OVERVIEW

With the PGA TOUR Season returning to a calendar-year spanning January to August, each week has greater impact in the season-long race for the FedExCup as well as in-season stakes, through Signature Event qualification. Players qualify for the limited-field tournaments via the top 50 previous season's FedExCup standings (BMW Championship) and can play their way in through the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5.

AON NEXT 10 and AON SWING 5

The Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 are eligibility pathways for players, not already qualified, to play their way into Signature Events via the FedExCup standings.



- Aon Next 10:** Top 10 available players, not otherwise exempt, from FedExCup standings. The Aon Next 10 will always fill to 10 players.
- Aon Swing 5:** Top five available players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points from events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Swing 5 will always fill to five players.

STORYLINES

The next Signature Event in the 2024 PGA TOUR Season is the RBC Heritage, played the week after the Masters Tournament. The Aon Next 10 is filled with the top 10 players in the FedExCup standings through the Masters that did not finish in the top 50 of the 2022-23 FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility Points List, while the Aon Swing 5 is made up of the next five players earning the most points in the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children's Houston Open and Valero Texas Open.

LAST WEEK ON TOUR: TEXAS CHILDREN'S HOUSTON OPEN

Stephan Jaeger won the Texas Children's Houston Open by one stroke, earning his first career PGA TOUR title in his 135th career start. With the win, Jaeger moved to No. 3 in the Aon Next 10 standings and secured a spot in the four remaining Signature Events in 2024. He has competed in two Signature Events to date, qualifying for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (T71) and Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard (T44) via the Aon Swing 5.

PLAYERS TO WATCH: VALERO TEXAS OPEN

The Valero Texas Open is the final tournament that counts toward the Aon Swing 5 for the RBC Heritage, and players 2-5 in the standings as well as all players not otherwise exempt within 60 points of No. 5 are in the field.

The winner (Brice Garnett) and runner-up (**Erik Barnes**) from the Puerto Rico Open remain 1-2 in the Aon Swing 5 standings entering the final week of the qualifying period. Barnes, who is competing on a Major Medical Extension this season after missing 10 months of competition following the 2023 Valspar Championship, finished T17 at last week's Texas Children's Houston Open and is making his tournament debut at the Valero Texas Open (Garnett is not in the field).

Billy Horschel enters the week No. 5 in the Aon Swing 5 standings and has not competed in a Signature Event this season. Horschel has three top-five finishes in nine career starts at the Valero Texas Open: T3/2013, 3rd/2015, T4/2016.

Ryan Moore, currently No. 8 in the Aon Swing 5 standings, has three top-10s in seven prior starts at the Valero Texas Open, highlighted by a solo-third in 2019.

SIGNATURE EVENTS ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility criteria for Signature Events (outside The Sentry):

- Top 50 in the previous season's FedExCup standings
- Aon Next 10
- Aon Swing 5
- If not exempt from a higher category listed above: current-year tournament winners (excluding Additional Events) and PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the OWGR
- Four sponsor exemptions (PGA TOUR members)
- The three player-hosted events each have one tournament host exemption, which is not restricted to PGA TOUR members

QUICK FACTS

- Field sizes for Signature Events are expected to be approximately 70-80 players (80 players for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am due to format)
- Increased purses (\$20 million)
- Increased FedExCup points (700 for the winner)
- No mandatory participation regulation for eligible players
- No cut, except for three player-hosted invitationals (Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, The Genesis Invitational, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)
