**Today** – High clouds will stream into the area, however it will be another dry and warm day at TPC San Antonio. Winds likely increase quickly between 8-10am with gusts remaining above 20 mph the entire day. Unlike yesterday, winds won't peak until late in the day with gusts of 25-30 mph developing after 3pm. A high temperature near 84 degrees is expected.

**Extended forecast** – Southerly flow will enhance low-level moisture across the Hill Country tonight into tomorrow. This, combined with an approaching weak front, could cause areas of drizzle or even some light rain showers to develop Saturday into Saturday night. A surge of drier air returns behind the front on Sunday with no weather concerns during the final round. Southerly winds will remain breezy on Saturday with gusts of 20-25 mph possible. Winds will become more variable on Sunday, however northerly winds could gust 15-20 mph during the morning before becoming southeasterly during the afternoon.
