### Peter Malnati (Won/-12)

- Captures his second career PGA TOUR win in his 259th start at 36 years, 9 months, 11 days
- Snaps a winless streak of 3,059 days (or 8 years, 4 months, 16 days) on the PGA TOUR (2015 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Eighth appearance at the Valspar Championship; missed six of his first seven cuts (best finish in that span: T60/2019)
- Eighth start of the season; previous best finish was T9 (Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- His No. 184 ranking in the Official World Golf Ranking is the second-highest by a Valspar Championship winner since 2008 (205th/Kevin Streelman/2013)
- Earns his third top-15 in his last five starts on TOUR; had three top-15s in his previous 30 starts
- Moves up to 16th in the FedExCup standings after starting the week 77th
- Moves up 29 spots in the Aon Next 10 to No. 6 for the RBC Heritage
- Matches his low 72-hole score of the season (272/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches/T9)

### Miscellaneous notes

- **Cameron Young** (2nd/-10) was the lone player in the field to card four rounds in the 60s; earns his seventh runner-up finish on the PGA TOUR, the most without a win since 1983 (previous: 6/Colin Montgomerie; 6/Briny Baird)
- Seeking his first win on the PGA TOUR, rookie Chandler Phillips (T3/-9) earns his best finish in 12 starts on TOUR
- 36-hole co-leader **Mackenzie Hughes** (T3/-9) earns his best finish of the 2024 season in his eighth start (previous: T25/The Sentry) and best finish at the Valspar Championship in his fourth start (previous: T13/2019); one of two players with fewer than 100 putts this week (Hughes/96, Matt Kuchar/99)
- Xander Schauffele (T5/-8) played Nos. 11-14 in 5-under en route to 65 and his third top-five in his last four starts on TOUR; matches Sam Ryder (T33/-2) for the low round of the day
- Robbie Shelton (T33/-2) made an albatross on the par-5 14th, holing his second shot from 258 yards with a 21-degree hybrid; was the second albatross in Valspar Championship history (Russell Knox/2019/R1/No. 11); was the third albatross on the PGA TOUR in 2024 (Jake Knapp/The American Express, Shane Lowry/Farmers Insurance Open)
- 54-hole leader Keith Mitchell (T17/-4) closed with 6-over 77

### Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5

• The next Signature Event on the schedule is the RBC Heritage. The cutoff for the Aon Next 10 is through the Masters Tournament while the events for the Aon Swing 5 are the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children's Houston Open and Valero Texas Open.
