Today – Low-pressure over the gulf will produce areas of rain and isolated thunderstorms through the day. Rain could be heavy at times, especially this afternoon with thunderstorms. Luckily, the higher thunderstorm chances will be across Southern Florida, keeping the heaviest rain accumulations to our south. Otherwise, the wind is expected to increase this morning and continue through the day out of the SE 15-20 gusting to 30 mph.

Extended forecast – The low-pressure system will move into Georgia by Saturday morning dragging a cold front through Central Florida. This will keep the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms for the first half of the day before drier conditions return Saturday afternoon. Partly cloudy skies and breezy conditions can be expected Sunday with highs in the mid to upper 70s. Warmer temperatures return Monday under mostly sunny skies.
