Extended forecast – After a chilly start Wednesday, temperatures will begin to moderate Wednesday afternoon into Thursday as the winds shift out of the southeast. Highs will warm back into the 70s each day. A developing low-pressure system over the northern gulf will bring rain and the chance for thunderstorms to Florida on Friday before shifting east late in the day. Rainfall could be heavy at times, especially with thunderstorms. Drier conditions are expected to return for the weekend with highs in the low to mid 70s.
