



## 2024 WM Phoenix Open ShotLink Broadcast Notes



### Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Scheffler earned his 5<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR Victory in his 94<sup>th</sup> career TOUR start. Scheffler returned to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Rankings.

- 3<sup>rd</sup>** Player to successfully defend a PGA TOUR Title Last Season, Scheffler is also the seventh player to defend their WM Phoenix Open title (*Last: Hideki Matsuyama 2017*)
- 87.50** scrambling percentage, his second highest in an event during his PGA TOUR Career
- +4.25** Strokes Gained: Approach the Green, the fourth most of any WM Phoenix Open winner through the final two rounds.
- 42** bogey free rounds, the most of any player on the PGA TOUR Since 2020. Scheffler has been bogey free in the final round 7 times in that time span.
- 5** fairways hit, Scheffler is one of 7 players in the ShotLink Era to hit 5 or fewer fairways multiple times in the final round and go on to win (*2022 Arnold Palmer Invitational, 5*)

### AON Next 10 and Swing 5 Breakdown

As the sixth week of the FedExCup Regular Season gets underway at the WM Phoenix Open, players will have an opportunity to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5, a new eligibility pathway with access to Signature Events. With the PGA TOUR Season returning to a calendar-year spanning January to August, each week has greater impact in the season-long race for the FedExCup as well as in-season stakes, with Full-Field Events holding additional consequence through the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5.

The Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 are eligibility pathways for players, not already qualified, to play their way into Signature Events via the FedExCup standings.

- Aon Next 10: Top 10 available players, not otherwise exempt, from FedExCup standings
- Aon Swing 5: Top five available players, not otherwise exempt, who have earned the most FedExCup points from the swings leading up to each Signature Event

The top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, while the top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during those three events and the WM Phoenix Open, will qualify for The Genesis Invitational. The Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the FedExCup Fall standings.

### 17<sup>th</sup> Hole – Par 4

**964 / 664** Tee shots have ended on the putting surface on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole (11.6%) while **685** tee shots have found the water (8.4%).

**4** players since 2003 have converted birdies after finding the water off the tee on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole

**4** Since 2003, there has only been four putts made from over 100 feet on the PGA TOUR. In 2011, Angel Cabrera made a 103' 5" putt on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole during the final round, marking the longest putt made on this hole and second longest putt made on TOUR in the ShotLink era.

**Only Par 4 Ace on TOUR:** Andrew Magee is responsible for the only par 4 ace recorded in tournament play on the PGA TOUR (2001, First Rd). Since 1987, there have been 14,858 rounds on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole in tournament play.
