Today – A quick moving cold front will push across Arizona today, bringing another round of showers to the Phoenix area. The window for showers will be brief, mainly between 12-4pm. However, there could be pockets of heavy rain and even a few strikes of lightning as this activity moves through. Brisk southerly winds, gusting 20-25 mph are possible ahead of, and directly behind the front. These winds likely begin to diminish by the late afternoon. Forecast rainfall: 0.10-0.25". **Sunrise: 7:18am / Sunset: 6:05pm**

Extended forecast – Dry but cold tonight as temperatures fall into the upper 30s. While some patchy frost can't be ruled out, there are some limiting factors in place. Dry conditions will persist through Friday with light winds. One last disturbance will reach the area on Saturday with another period of showers expected, mainly during the morning hours. The coldest night of the week will occur Saturday night into Sunday with temperatures dropping towards the freezing mark. Areas of frost are possible if winds diminish enough.
