Nico Echavarria (T1/-12)

- With a second-round score of 9-under 63, records career-best 18-hole score on TOUR
- Seeks third career PGA TOUR victory in his 59th start, won the 2024 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP in most recent start
- Last to win in back-to-back starts on TOUR: Rory McIlroy (2024 Zurich Classic of New Orleans, 2024 Truist Championship)
- Holds second career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR in back-to-back starts (2024 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)
- Only player bogey-free through 36-holes
- Making second start at the World Wide Technology Championship (T31/2023)
- Enters the week at No. 65 in the FedExCup Fall standings
- Has two top-10 finishes in 27 starts this season: T4/Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with partner Max Greyserman), won/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP

Max Greyserman (T1/-12)

- First career 36-hole lead/co-lead; previous-best 36-hole position: T2 at 2024 Wyndham Championship (finished 2nd)
- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 27th start
- Would join Brian Gay (2008), John Huh (2012) and Patton Kizzire (2017) as first-time winners of the event
- Would be the 14th first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Matt McCarty (Black Desert Championship)
- Recorded third runner-up finish this season in most recent start (3M Open, Wyndham Championship, ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)
- Seeks to become the second player this season to finish runner-up and win the next tournament on the PGA TOUR schedule (T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP), joining Davis Thompson (T2/Rocket Mortgage Classic, Won/John Deere Classic)
- Would be the fifth rookie to win on TOUR this season (sixth total win), joining Nick Dunlap (2), Matthieu Pavon, Jake Knapp, Matt McCarty

Miscellaneous notes

- **Carson Young** (3rd/-11) follows an opening round even-par with a career-best 11-under 61, tying the tournament 18-hole scoring record (Roland Thatcher/R3/2008, Matthew Wolff/R1/2021)
- Beau Hossler (T35/-5) followed a 76 with a 9-under 63 in the second round, highlighted by a hole-in-one on the par-3 11th (179 yards/8-iron), his first ace on TOUR in a stroke-play
- San Miguel d Allende, Mexico native **Emilio Gonzalez** was disqualified after the second round due to a breach of Rule 18.3. (Provisional Ball)

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Currently projected to move into Nos. 51-60: Nico Echavarria (T1; from No. 65 to No. 51)
- Currently projected to fall out of Nos. 51-60: Kevin Yu (DNP; from No. 59 to No. 61)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
- Currently projected to move into the Top 125: **Dylan Wu** (4th; from No. 134 to No. 114), **Joe Highsmith** (T8; from No. 126 to No. 119)
- Currently projected to fall out of the Top 125: S.H. Kim (MC; from No. 122 to No. 126), Matt Wallace (DNP; from No. 125 to No. 129)
