## Austin Eckroat (Winner/-24)

- Second PGA TOUR title in his 70<sup>th</sup> start at the age of 25 years, 9 months, 29 days
- PGA TOUR wins (2): 2024 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2024 World Wide Technology Championship
- Seventh player with multiple victories on TOUR this season: (Scottie Scheffler/7, Rory McIlroy/2, Robert MacIntyre/2, Xander Schauffele/2, Nick Dunlap/2, Hideki Matsuyama/2, Austin Eckroat/2)
- 63 ties his career-low score on TOUR (2023 CJ CUP Byron Nelson/R3)
- Career-high 11 birdies in a round on TOUR (previous: 10/2023 CJ CUP Byron Nelson /R3); led the field in birdies for the tournament (30)
- Entered the week with one top-10 in 19 starts since his victory at the Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches (6<sup>th</sup>/Wyndham Championship)
- In his second season on TOUR, finished 45<sup>th</sup> in the 2024 FedExCup Playoffs
- As a rookie during the 2022-23 season, finished 74<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup Fall standings; earned his PGA TOUR card through the Korn Ferry Tour in 2022
- Fourth appearance at the World Wide Technology Championship and his second at El Cardonal at Diamante (T23/2023)
- In the tournament's two years at El Cardonal at Diamante, the winner cards a 63 in the final round (Erik van Rooyen)

## **Miscellaneous notes**

- 54-hole co-leader Justin Lower (T2/-23) eagles the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole to finish runner-up for his career-high finish on TOUR; owns four top-five finishes in his last 66 career starts on TOUR (T4/2022 Procore Championship, T3/2024 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld, T4/2024 Corales Puntacana Championship)
- In his second season on TOUR, 54-hole co-leader **Carson Young** (T2/-23) finishes runner-up for his career-high finish on TOUR (previous: T3/2023 Puerto Rico Open)
- Max Greyserman (4<sup>th</sup>/-22) collects his fourth top-five finish in his last six starts on TOUR: (2<sup>nd</sup>/3M Open, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Wyndham Championship, T2/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP)
- After entering the week No. 126 in the FedExCup Fall standings, PGA TOUR rookie Joe Highsmith (5<sup>th</sup>/-19) moves to No. 112; solo-fifth finish marks his career-high finish on TOUR and third top-10 this season (T6/Puerto Rico Open, Black Desert Championship)

## FedExCup Fall Notes

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational; no players moved into Nos. 51-60 this week
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season

- Moved into the Top 125: Joe Highsmith (5<sup>th</sup>; from No. 126 to No. 112), Daniel Berger (T20; from No. 129 to No. 124)
- Fell out of the Top 125: S.H. Kim (MC; from No. 122 to No. 127), Matt Wallace (DNP; from No. 125 to No. 130)
