Today – The remnants of Debby has moved north and will continue to accelerate away from the region today. Scattered light showers will be likely through 8am before shifting to the east and allowing drier conditions to return. A cold front will push through the area during the late afternoon/early evening. This may produce a few showers and isolated thunderstorms as it passes. Any shower or storms could produce heavy rainfall in a short period of time.

Extended forecast – Partly cloudy skies and hot temperatures can be expected Saturday as the cold front will stall to the south and east of the area. A weak area of low pressure will develop along the front and move to the northeast through Sunday. This will produce scattered showers and thunderstorms across the eastern half of the state through the weekend. Cannot rule out an isolated thunderstorm developing across the Triad, but most locations should remain dry through Sunday.
