Today – Flash Flood Watch Until 9PM Friday! Rain will continue through the rest of the day as Tropical Storm Debby moves to the northwest through South Carolina. Rain will be heavy at times, especially with any thunderstorms this afternoon. Flash flooding will be likely at times as well. Easterly winds of 15-20 gusting to 30-35 mph will be likely with higher gusts to 40-45 mph possible with thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – The remnants of Debby will move through Central North Carolina early Friday morning as it accelerates northward. Lingering showers and isolated storms will be possible through mid-morning Friday before shifting east. Scattered showers and thunderstorms may redevelop during the late afternoon/early evening Friday as a cold front moves through the area. Drier conditions return Saturday with mostly sunny skies and highs in the mid-80s. Cooler and less humid conditions can be expected Sunday into Monday with highs in the low 80s.
