Today – The cold front has stalled along Central North Carolina and will be the focus for scattered showers and thunderstorms redeveloping during the afternoon and evening hours. The higher likelihood for storms will be just to the south and east of Greensboro. However, cannot rule out a shower or thunderstorm developing over Greensboro. Otherwise, it will be another partly cloudy, hot and humid day with highs in the upper 80s.

Extended forecast – The stalled front will remain across Central North Carolina keeping the chance for showers and thunderstorms to the south and east of Greensboro on Sunday. Some drier air will move into the area during the afternoon making for less humid conditions with highs in the mid 80s. Cooler and less humid conditions will continue Monday with highs in the low 80s. The stalled front will begin to lift back to the north on Tuesday bringing the chances back for afternoon showers and thunderstorms.
