Nico Echavarria (Winner/-20)

- Earns second career PGA TOUR win in his 58th start (2023 Puerto Rico Open) at the age of 30 years, 2 months, 23 days
- Collects 500 points and moves to No. 65 in the FedExCup Standings after entering the week No. 113
- Improves to 2-for-2 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead (2023 Puerto Rico Open)
- Posts career low 72-hole score of 260 (previous: 267/2023 Puerto Rico Open/1st)
- At 20-under 260, sets tournament 72-hole low score (previous: 261/Tiger Woods/2019)
- Becomes second international winner of the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, joining Hideki Matsuyama (Japan/2021)
- Win comes in his ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP debut, won the 2023 Puerto Rico Open in his first start at the event
- Records second top-10 this season (T4/Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Max Greyserman)

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his third ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP start, 15-time PGA TOUR winner **Justin Thomas** (T2/-19) records his second runner-up at the event (T2/2020) and seventh runner-up on TOUR, his highest finish since he won the 2022 PGA Championship
- PGA TOUR rookie **Max Greyserman** (T2/-19) finishes runner-up for the third time in 26 starts (3M Open, Wyndham Championship) in bid to become the first first-time winner of the event and 14th first-time winner of the season
- With a solo-fourth finish at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, six-time PGA TOUR winner **Rickie Fowler** (4th/-17) records his first top-10 since his win at the 2023 Rocket Mortgage Classic (a span of 29 starts)
- Making his PGA TOUR debut, **Yuta Sugiura** (T6/-13) records best finish among the 14 Japanese players in the field; 2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP winner **Hideki Matsuyama** finished at T46

FedExCup Fall Notes

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational
 - Moved into Nos. 51-60: Ben Griffin (T22; No. 62 to No. 60)
 - Fell out Nos. 51-60: Jake Knapp (Not in field; No. 59 to No. 61)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
 - Moved into the Top 125: Joel Dahmen (T41; No. 129 to No. 124)
 - Fell out of the Top 125: Joe Highsmith (Not in field; No. 125 to No. 126)
