Things to Know

- Seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions, **Robert Karlsson** remained bogey-free for the tournament on Saturday and takes a two-stroke lead over **Charlie Wi** entering the final round.
- The top 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings (Ernie Els, Stephen Ames and Steven Alker) share fourth place, seven strokes behind Karlsson.

Robert Karlsson, 66-65 - 131 (-13)

- Is the only player in the field without a bogey after 36 holes
- This is his fifth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 Is 0-for-4 converting those into victories
- The 54-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (82nd start)
 - Best finish: 2nd/T2 (five times)
- Making his 12th start of the 2024 season, he has two top-10 finishes
 - Best finish of 2024: T7 (Kaulig Companies Championship)
- With a win on Sunday, he would snap a winless streak of 13 years, 8 months, 14 days (or 5,005 days), dating back to the 2010 DP World Tour Championship
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the second time this season
 Previous instance: Kaulig Companies Championship (finished T7)
- Making his fourth appearance the Boeing Classic, his best finish is T45 (2022)
- Made 132 starts on the PGA TOUR, most recently in 2015
 - Best finish: 2nd/T2 (2010 FedEx St. Jude Classic; 2011 FedEx St. Jude Classic)
- Earned 10 wins on the DP World Tour (410 starts)
 - Last win: 2010 DP World Tour Championship

- Seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (40th start), Charlie Wi carded the low round of the day with 8under 64. He sits in 2nd at 11-under.
 - With a win on Sunday, he would snap a winless streak of 18 years, 5 months, 23 days (or 6,748 days), dating back to the 2006 Maybank Malaysian Open.
- 62-year-old **Kirk Triplett** sits in 3rd at 7-under after posting 70. He seeks his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions (270th start).
 - Last win: 2019 PURE Insurance Championship
- The top 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings (No. 1 Ernie Els, No. 2 Stephen Ames and No. 3 Steven Alker) are each T4 at 6-under.
 - o Alker, who was one of four first-round co-leaders, seeks his second win of the 2024 season.
 - Els, a member of the World Golf Hall of Fame, seeks his fourth win of the season, which would extend his lead for the most victories among all players in 2024.
 - Ames, the defending champion of the Boeing Classic, seeks his third win of the season, which would match Els for the most by any player in 2024.
 - First-round co-leader **Woody Austin** sits T7 at 5-under along with **David Bransdon**.
- 2015 champion **Billy Andrade** is among the five players T9 at 4-under.
- Two-time champion (2010, 2016) Bernhard Langer shot bogey-free 69 and sits T14 at 3-under.
- Seattle native Fred Couples, making his first PGA TOUR Champions start since March, is T14 at 3-under.
- First-round co-leader **Gene Sauers** carded 75 and sits T14 at 3-under.
- **Duffy Waldorf** (back) withdrew before the start of the second round.
