Today – A mixture of sun and clouds can be expected much of the day with elevated wildfire smoke creating hazy/milky skies. Scattered showers/T-storms are expected to develop in the mountains east of the course after 1-2pm. While dry conditions likely persist at the course, lightning could come within 20 miles. Otherwise, it will be warm once again with temperatures reaching the upper 80s. Light westerly winds can be expected throughout the day. **Sunrise: 5:56am / Sunset: 8:28pm**

Extended forecast – Increasing onshore flow this weekend will lead to cooling temperatures and increased cloud cover. Saturday will likely be the warmer/sunnier of the two days and this will allow temperatures to climb into the 80s. Marine clouds likely thicken Saturday night into Sunday morning and may struggle to burn off during the day Sunday. A low threat for drizzle will also be mentioned in the forecast. Cool and cloudy/drizzly conditions should persist into Monday as well.
