Things to Know

- 67-year-old World Golf Hall of Fame member **Bernhard Langer** made birdie on the 72nd hole to win the Charles Schwab Cup Championship by one stroke and capture his record-extending 47th victory on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Playing alongside Langer in the final group, **Steven Alker** (T2) won the Charles Schwab Cup for the second time in three years, becoming the seventh multi-time winner of the season-long race on PGA TOUR Champions.

Bernhard Langer, 69-64-67-66 – 266 (-18)

Charles Schwab Cup standings – Start: 22nd / Finish: 7th

- The 67-year-old earned his record-extending 47th win on PGA TOUR Champions (356 starts)
 - Previous win: 2023 U.S. Senior Open
 - Has two more wins than second-most all-time on PGA TOUR Champions (Hale Irwin, 45 wins)
- Earned his first win of the 2024 season (16 starts)
 - Previous best finish in 2024: 2nd – lost in playoff (Ascension Charity Classic)
- This is his 18th consecutive year (17th consecutive season) with a win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Has at least one win every year on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to 2007
 - Note: He won during both calendar years during the 2020-21 wrap-around season
- Extended his record as the oldest winner in PGA TOUR Champions history (67 years, 2 months, 14 days)
 - Now holds the top six spots on the oldest winners list
- This is his 14th win since turning 60 years old, most in PGA TOUR Champions history
 - That number alone would rank T18 on the PGA TOUR Champions all-time wins list
- Has won 13.2% of his starts on PGA TOUR Champions (47 wins in 356 starts)
 - Ranks second among players with 10 or more wins, behind only Steve Stricker (24.0%)
- Earned his first win at the Charles Schwab Cup Championship (16 appearances)



- Previous best finish at this event: 2nd/T2 (2013, 2015, 2016)
- This is the 25th different tournament on PGA TOUR Champions that he has won
 - Has won 17 of the 28 events on the 2024 schedule at some point during his career
- Finished No. 7 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after starting the week ranked No. 22
 - This is his 12th consecutive season finishing in the top 10 of the final Charles Schwab Cup standings, dating back to 2012
 - Has finished in the top 10 of the final Charles Schwab Cup standings in 15 of his 17 seasons on PGA TOUR Champions
- Shot his age or better for the third consecutive day and 23rd time overall on PGA TOUR Champions
- This was the low 72-hole score of the 2024 season on PGA TOUR Champions (266)

Other Notes

- Defending champion **Steven Alker** closed with 66 to finish T2 at 17-under and won the Charles Schwab Cup. In three appearances at this event, Alker has finished (chronologically) 3rd-Won-T2.
- **Richard Green** used a back-nine 30 to shoot 65 and finished T2 at 17-under. This was his fifth runner-up finish of the 2024 season (26 starts) as he finishes No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- **Alex Cejka** finished 4th at 13-under after carding 68.
- **Rod Pampling** shot 68 to finish 5th at 10-under.
- 18- and 36-hole leader **Stewart Cink** finished T6 at 9-under.
- 2022 champion **Padraig Harrington** finished T8 at 8-under after closing with 68. The World Golf Hall of Fame member finishes No. 4 in the final Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- **Miguel Angel Jimenez** (T8) carded the low round of the day with 7-under 64.



- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els**, who entered the week atop the Charles Schwab Cup standings, finished T13 at 7-under. He finishes No. 2 in the final standings after leading for 12 of the 28 weeks during the 2024 season.

Steven Alker (2024 Charles Schwab Cup winner)

- Captured his second Charles Schwab Cup (2022, 2024)
 - Alker’s finishes by season in the Charles Schwab Cup standings: 18th (2020-21), Won (2022), 2nd (2023), Won (2024)
- Becomes the seventh multi-time winner of the Charles Schwab Cup in its 23-season history
 - Other players to win multiple Schwab Cups: Bernhard Langer (6), Tom Lehman (2), Loren Roberts (2), Jay Haas (2), Tom Watson (2), Hale Irwin (2)
- Led the Charles Schwab Cup standings after 12 weeks of the 28-week season
 - Other players to lead the Charles Schwab Cup standings in 2024: Ernie Els (12 weeks), Stephen Ames (4 weeks)
 - Alker entered this week ranked No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- The 53-year-old earned one win during the 2024 season (22 starts)
 - Won the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (Jan. 18-20)
 - In 22 starts during the 2024 season, he notched 16 top-10s, including five runner-up finishes
