#### Things to Know

- With the final round of the Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO canceled due to inclement weather, by virtue of his 36-hole lead, **Stephen Ames** becomes the 2024 champion at 13-under 131
- The last PGA TOUR Champions event reduced to 36 holes due to inclement weather was the 2021 Insperity Invitational

#### Stephen Ames (1<sup>st</sup>-13)

- On the strength of a 67-64 start in rounds one and two, respectively, wins by three strokes at 13-under 131 in his ninth Chubb Classic start; marks his third top-10 finish in the event: 1<sup>st</sup>/2024, T9/2020, T6/2019
- This week’s victory marks his seventh career win on PGA TOUR Champions and fifth in his most recent 24 starts; amassed four wins on the PGA TOUR in 394 starts (including the 2006 PLAYERS Championship)
- The win comes after securing a T8 at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai

#### Other Notes

- First-round leader **Rocco Mediate**’s opening round 9-under 63 helped propel him to runner-up honors at 10-under 134; the runner-up finish marks his 39<sup>th</sup> top-10 showing on PGA TOUR Champions and becomes his best finish since winning the 2019 Sanford International
- On the strength of a second-round 6-under 66, **Paul Broadhurst** finishes T3 at 9-under 135, his 37<sup>th</sup> top-10 showing in his 176<sup>th</sup> start on PGA TOUR Champions; marks his best finish since runner-up honors at the 2023 American Family Insurance Championship
- Making his fifth Chubb Classic start, 2021 champion **Steve Stricker** posts rounds of 69-67—136 (-8) to finish T7, marking his fourth top-10 finish in the event: T2/2018, T11/2019, 1<sup>st</sup>/2021, T2/2023, T7/2024

- With his 70-67 start to reach 7-under 137 (9<sup>th</sup>), **Davis Love III** claims his seventh top-10 finish on PGA TOUR Champions and first since a T7 at the 2022 Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS
- Looking for a third win in as many starts on PGA TOUR Champions, **Steven Alker** finishes T15 at 5-under 139
