The forecast will mention this threat, however these showers likely remain north/east of La Paloma. Otherwise, temperatures will be cool, only reaching the lower 60s. Winds should remain under 15 mph. Forecast rainfall: Trace. **Sunrise: 6:41am / Sunset: 6:27pm**
