Things to Know

- Beginning the day a shot off the lead, 2024 World Golf Hall of Fame inductee Padraig Harrington played his last four holes in 4-under en route to a 4-under 67 to claim a one-stroke lead in his bid for a seventh win on PGA TOUR Champions
- Making his second start in the Hoag Classic (T2/2023), reigning Charles Schwab Cup champion Steve Stricker is
 T5 at 8-under 134 after starting with back-to-back 4-under 67s; having not finished outside the top 10 in back-toback starts since January 2019, he comes to this week's Hoag Classic after a T32 showing in his most recent
 start at the Cologuard Classic

Padraig Harrington (1st/-12)

- Following a bogey at No. 14, played his last four holes in 4-under (eagle-par-birdie-birdie), good for a 4-under 67 and one-stroke lead
- When holding at least a share of the 36-hole lead on PGA TOUR Champions in 54-hole events, has converted for the win on both occasions (2022 Ascension Charity Classic, 2023 TimberTech Championship)
- In his only previous Hoag Classic start, finished T7 in 2023
- Seeking a seventh win on PGA TOUR Champions and first since the 2023 TimberTech Championship
- 2024 World Golf Hall of Fame inductee amassed six wins on the PGA TOUR, including the 2007 and 2008 Open Championship, as well as the 2008 PGA Championship

Other Notes

- After tying his career-low score of 9-under 62 in round one, 18-hole leader Thongchai Jaidee signed for a 2-under 69 and will begin the final round a stroke off Padraig Harrington's lead; seeks a third PGA TOUR Champions victory (2022 American Family Insurance Championship, 2023 PURE Insurance Championship)
- With three birdies and an eagle, Miguel Angel Jimenez played his last six holes in 5-under before signing for a 3-under 68; at 9-under 133, is vying for his 14th win on PGA TOUR Champions and first since the 2022 Boeing Classic

- **Jerry Kelly**, who was not feeling well early in the week, has opened with matching 3-under 68s to reach T11 at 6-under 136; best of four previous Hoag Classic starts was T21 in his most recent start of 2022
- Ricardo Gonzalez, who won the Trophy Hassan II last month, overcame an opening-round 1-over 72 with the low round of the day, a bogey-free 7-under 64; will enter Sunday's final round T11 at 6-under 136
- 2020 and 2023 Hoag Classic champion **Ernie Els** improved on his opening 1-under 70 with a 3-under 68 in round two, putting him at 4-under 138; the defending champion will begin Sunday's final round eight strokes back
- Citing "injury," Fred Couples withdrew after nine holes in round two
