Additional Notes

- Winter was mild, but most of spring has been cool, cloudy and wet which increased disease pressure of zoysiagrass fairways.
- In the past year an additional 4,000 feet of drainage was added to the fairways to help with the spring transition.
- The 2019 renovation including changing greens from bentgrass to bermuda and other areas from bermuda to zoysia.
- Michael Moore's brother and nephew are also superintendents in the area.
