### Things to Know

- 36-hole leader **Steven Alker** matched the low 54-hole score in PGA TOUR Champions history (191) on his way to a four-stroke win at the season-opening Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
- Key Moment: Alker held a two-stroke lead over **Steve Stricker** and **Harrison Frazar** when his second shot on the par-5 seventh sailed right of the green. But the ball bounced off the cart path and ricocheted off the lava before rolling onto the green, where he drained a 40-foot putt for eagle. Alker took a three-stroke lead after Stricker and Frazar each birdied No. 7 and never looked back.
- With his win, Alker takes the lead in the Charles Schwab Cup standings. Either Alker or Stricker has led the Charles Schwab Cup standings for 47 of the last 50 weeks, dating back to May 2022.

### Steven Alker, 65-63-63 – 191 (-25)

- The 52-year-old earned his eighth win on PGA TOUR Champions (54 starts)
  - Has at least one win in each of his four seasons, dating back to 2021
- Matched the low 54-hole score in PGA TOUR Champions history (191)
  - This is the seventh instance of a player shooting 191 on PGA TOUR Champions
    - Matched the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai scoring record (Loren Roberts/2006)
  - Alker's previous best 54-hole score: 196 (2023 Charles Schwab Cup Championship)
- Becomes the first player to win back-to-back tournaments on PGA TOUR Champions since Steve Stricker (2023 Regions Tradition, 2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship)
  - In his last start, Alker won the 2023 Charles Schwab Cup Championship
- In three appearances at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, he has finished 2nd-T2-1st
  - His scoring average at this event is 65.44 (nine rounds)
- Improved to 5-for-7 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions

### Other Notes

- Seeking his second win in his last four starts, first-timer at Hualalai **Harrison Frazar** finished runner-up at 21-under after closing with bogey-free 65.
- Defending champion and reigning PGA TOUR Champions Player of the Year **Steve Stricker** finished third at 20-under. Stricker has finished in the top 3 in 16 of his last 21 starts on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to August 2022.

- **David Toms** closed with 65 to finish fourth at 17-under.
- First-timer at Hualalai **Stewart Cink** finished T5 at 14-under for his fourth top-10 in his first five starts on PGA TOUR Champions.
- 2021 champion **Darren Clarke** posted back-to-back 66s over the final two rounds en route to a seventh-place finish.
- 2018 champion **Jerry Kelly** finished T8 at 12-under after closing with 66.
