Richard, 65 today – great round. What was going well for you?

It was just a matter of playing a little bit more solid than yesterday. Yesterday was really tough with the wind and we didn't quite have as much wind today, so I was able to sort of settle in to the rhythm a little bit better today, I think. You know, putting great and hitting the ball really nicely, so you know, just got to just keep the belief going.

Safe to say more comfortable today for you?

Yeah, absolutely. It was a bit nicer out there today. You know, the course is drying out – I like that. You know, the ball's running down the fairway a little bit and it's bouncy on the green, so it was pretty much what I'm used to. So yeah, I was a bit more comfortable.

Why do you enjoy a hard and fast golf course?

It's just one of those things I grew up on. You know, it's something engrained in the system there somewhere. I always like to see the ball bounce and up to the hole and you know, it's nice to get out on a golf course when it's doing that. Senior Open this year was like that, U.S. Senior Open was like that, I played well. So, you know, I can only hope the conditions stay that way tomorrow.

This isn't your first time doing this on a Saturday. What's it going to take to finally get through?

You know, just keep doing what I've been doing. I'm not going to try to put any extra pressure on myself. I've been playing good golf, hitting good golf shots, my process has been good, my practice has been good. You just keep doing the same things over and over again. If they're good, you stick to it and hopefully the cards will fall your way eventually.

Are you familiar with this course at all? Have you played here?

I played last year and last year was very much getting my head around the golf courses on this tour. I played pretty well here last year from memory – top 10 I think. Hopefully, I'll be better tomorrow.
