- Invited Celebrity Classic The second round was canceled due to storms in the Dallas-Fort Worth area on Saturday, April 20. In accordance with PGA TOUR Champions Regulations, the Invited Celebrity Classic's results through 36 holes served as the final standings.
- Insperity Invitational The first round was postponed to Saturday, May 4 due to weather conditions on Friday, May 3. Competitors played 36 holes on Saturday. The final round was canceled on Sunday, May 5. In accordance with PGA TOUR Champions Regulations, the Insperity Invitational's results through 36 holes served as the final standings.
