Myles Creighton (T1/-15)

- Second-year Korn Ferry Tour member chipped in for birdie on the par-4 18th for an 11-under 59, matching Adrien Dumont De Chassart's first-round 11-under 59 for the second sub-60 score of the week; marks the 15th sub-60 round in Tour history
 - Second time in Korn Ferry Tour history in which multiple sub-60 rounds have been recorded during the same event (2024 Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard, Cristobal Del Solar/13under 57/R1; Aldrich Potgieter/11-under 59/R2)
 - Made 12 birdies against one bogey en route to his 11-under 59, becoming the 13th player in Tour history to record 12 birdies in a single round
- Recorded two eagles during his second round with a hole-in-one on the par-3 12th and a hole out on the par-4 15th for a 2-under 68, matching his opening round score
- Holds first 54-hole lead/co-lead in his 41st start on the Korn Ferry Tour (previous best 54-hole position: T5/2024 Veritex Bank Championship/finished 2nd)
- Bidding for first career Korn Ferry Tour victory and to become the 21st Canadian to win on Tour (last: Sudarashan Yellamaraju/2025 The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club)
- Finished No. 45 on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List as a rookie behind four top-25s and three top-10s, highlighted by a runner-up finish at the Veritex Bank Championship
- Finished No. 2 in the 2023 PGA TOUR Lationamérica Order of Merit behind five top-10s and a win at the Inter Rapidisimo Golf Championship, earning conditional membership for the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour season

Quade Cummins (T1/-15)

• Class of 2024 Korn Ferry Tour graduate bidding for first career Korn Ferry Tour victory (previous best finish: T2/2024 The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic)

- At 15-under 195 ties 54-hole career low, previously set at the 2024 Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank and Intermountain Health (18-under/195)
- First lead/co-lead after three rounds of play on the Korn Ferry Tour (previous 54-hole best: 3rd/2022 HomeTown Lenders Championship/finished T4; T3/2024 Adventhealth Championship/finished T8)
- Making fifth career start at the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Wichita Open; made the cut in all five starts (best finish: T38/2024)
- PGA TOUR rookie who's made nine cuts in 15 starts this season with two top-25s (best: T12/Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- Earned PGA TOUR membership with a No. 11 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, logging 14 top-25s with six top-10 finishes (best: T2/The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club)
- Finished No. 6 in the inaugural PGA TOUR University Class of 2021 after six seasons at University of Oklahoma (2015-21)

Additional Notes

- Three-time Korn Ferry Tour winner Pierceson Coody (T3/-14) stands inside the top five after three rounds for the fourth time this season; finished inside the top-10 in all three previous instances (T2/The Bahamas Golf Classic at Atlantis Paradise Island/finished T7; T2/The Panama Championship/finished T9; T3/BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEEX/finished T2)
- Ian Holt (T6/-9), who finished No. 10 in the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas Fortinet Cup, at 14-under 196 records the lowest 54-hole score of his career (previous low: 13-under 197/118 VISA Argentina Open presented by Macro)
- Third-year member **Emilio Gonzalez** (T5/-12), who made his Major Championship debut at last week's U.S. Open, matches his 18-hole career low with an 8-under 62 (8-under 62/2024 Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation/R3)
- Second round co-leader **Harry Hillier** (T5/-12), who finished No. 7 in the 2024 PGA TOUR Americas Fortinet Cup, logs the best 54-hole position of his career in his ninth start on Tour (previous best: T31/2025 Club Car Championship at The Landings Golf & Athletic Club/finished T6)
- **Mitchell Meissner** (T5/-12) stands inside the top 10 after 54 holes for the fourth time this season, seeking his sixth top-10 finish of the year to match Hank Lebioda for the most on Tour
- Conditional member **Billy Tom Sargent** (T8/-10), who earned a start in this week's tournament with a T24 at the BMW Charity Pro-Am, cards a bogey-free 6-under 64
 - One of two bogey-free rounds on the day; **Chandler Blanchet** (T14/-9) had the other at 5-under 65
