**Today** – Dry and sunny conditions expected today. Winds will be light and mainly out of the east through the morning, with the sea breeze likely moving through around 12pm, switching the winds to a more westerly direction. A few gusts of up to 12-14 mph possible once that sea breeze moves through. Temps warm up as well, with highs in the upper 80s this afternoon.

**Extended Forecast** – Dry the rest of the week. Winds Friday and Saturday will pick up and become stronger as easterly flow will likely keep the sea breeze pinned to the coast, therefore keeping us with easterly winds the entirety of each day. Saturday still appears to have the highest wind gust potential, with up to 25-30 mph gusts possible in the afternoon. No changes with the temps, as those are still on track to ramp up late in the week as well, with highs pushing to around 90F Fri-Sat.
