**Today** – A weak front will reach central Illinois by this afternoon with the potential for showers/T-storms developing. While the greatest threat for showers/T-storms will be south of Springfield, there will be a 15-35% for development near the course much of the afternoon. Temperatures should fall just short of 90F this afternoon with peak feels like temperatures of 94-97F. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15" but localized higher amounts are possible in a T-storm. **Sunrise: 5:32am / Sunset: 8:30pm**

**Extended forecast** – Shower/T-storm chances will end this evening with clearing skies overnight. Areas of fog will be possible, especially if rainfall occurs today. Dry conditions should prevail on Saturday with the next storm threat developing by Sunday afternoon. Temperatures will climb back into the 90-92F range this weekend with peak feels like temperatures of 95-100F.
