**Today** – The stretch of hot/humid conditions across central Illinois continues. Temperatures will reach the lower 90s with a peak feels like temperature right around 100F. The forecast will also mention a very low (10-15%) threat for an isolated T-storm this afternoon, however dry conditions are favored throughout the day. Southwest winds will increase with gusts of 15-20 mph possible this afternoon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10". **Sunrise: 5:32am / Sunset: 8:30pm**

**Extended forecast** – A weak front will reach central Illinois on Friday with shower/T-storm development expected around the area. With that said, the timing of the front could keep the main T-storm threat south of Springfield. Dry conditions are expected on Saturday with another threat for T-storms returning Sunday afternoon. Temperatures will range from the upper 80s to lower 90s each day with peak feels like temperatures of 95-100F.
