Today – While a brief shower can't be completely ruled out this morning into the early afternoon, coverage looks sparse and more dry periods are expected than wet. Higher changes for isolated showers and thunderstorms exist later in the day today, but coverage will be of the hit-or-miss variety. High temperatures reach the low 80s with a northeast breeze off Lake Michigan, mainly less than 10 mph. **Rainfall: Trace-0.10**"

Extended forecast – Scattered showers and embedded thunderstorms from overnight Friday are expected to linger in the area Saturday morning with periods of moderate to heavy rainfall possible through the day Saturday. Locally higher rainfall amounts are possible than the amounts listed above depending on where the heaviest showers/thunderstorms set up. It looks like a slightly drier air mass moves back into the area on Sunday, but with highs returning to the low 90s and just enough moisture lingering around there could be a few isolated showers around the Chicago area. Winds look light through the weekend, becoming southerly during each afternoon but largely remaining below 10 mph.
