Today – While a brief shower/weak thunderstorm can't be ruled out before 1-2pm, higher precipitation chances exist later this afternoon after around 1-2pm. Heavy showers and thunderstorms have potential for locally higher rainfall amounts. Excessive heat continues with temperatures in the low 90s, with heat indices likely exceed 100F this afternoon before showers/thunderstorms develop. Southwesterly winds reach sustained values to 10-14 mph with occasional gusts to 18-22 mph possible.

Extended forecast – Coverage of showers and thunderstorms has decreased on Friday, though a few brief showers or weak thunderstorms remain possible throughout the day. Another round of heavy showers and embedded thunderstorms returns overnight Friday/Saturday morning and lingers through the day on Saturday. The area finally starts to dry out Saturday evening. Winds look to generally remain below 10-12 mph through Sunday and will be east-northeasterly on Friday/Sunday and southwesterly on Saturday.
