Extended Forecast – Saturday, isolated showers and storms remain possible in the morning as a cold front moves through the area. Highest storm chances expected to be from 6-11am Sat, but these will be very sporadic/hit-ormiss. Any rain then likely clears to the east by late morning with dry conditions during the afternoon. Sunday, scattered showers and storms possible through the early morning, with dry weather returning before storm chances pick back up in the evening. Primary storm chances appear to be from 3-7am Sun and again after 6-7pm Sun. Winds lessen Saturday and Sunday and turn more northerly as that stalled frontal boundary sits near to just south of Omaha. Temperatures also lessen with the passage of that front, with much more comfortable highs in the low to mid 80s.
