Today – Showers and isolated storms will be possible through 10-11am or so along the slow-moving cold front. This rain will be much lighter, but stray strikes will be possible in this activity. A mostly dry period is then expected midday through mid-afternoon, but there are now suggestions that this AM activity could throw some lingering boundaries/circulations that may develop more showers and storms in the afternoon. Primary afternoon storm timing if this occurs: 3-6pm. Dry conditions return after 6pm this evening through sunset. Winds will turn to the north-northeast behind this front, with highs in the lower 80s.

Sunday – Storms are likely overnight tonight into Sunday morning, with the highest storm chances between 11pm Sat-4am Sun. Some lingering showers and storms will be possible through 6-7am Sunday morning, but then most of this activity should clear to the south. A mostly dry morning through early afternoon is then expected. Confidence is increasing that another boundary will bring shower and storm chances between mainly 3-6pm Sunday afternoon before drying out once again after 6pm. Highs will push into the upper 70s with lower northeast winds with gusts up to 15 mph.
