Chandler Blanchet (1st/-27)

- Earns his first career Korn Ferry Tour title in his 89th career start at 29 years, 5 months, 26 days of age
- Cards a final-round 4-under 68 via five birdies against one bogey to win by three strokes over Patrick Welch; marks the seventh time this season that a winner has won by at least three strokes (most recent: Austin Smotherman/BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX)
- With his victory, improves to No. 7 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List (top 20 from Points List earn PGA TOUR membership upon the conclusion of the Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by United Leasing & Finance)
- Becomes the first wire-to-wire winner of the season, leading outright after every round of the Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Hiland Dairy Foods; also becomes just the third wire-to-wire champion in the event's 36-year history
- Becomes the 12th first-time winner and the 12th player under the age of 30 to win this season
- Logged his second top-25 finish in his fourth career appearance at the event (others: T15/2024, T37/2022, MC/2020)
- Four-day total of 27-under 261 matches the second-lowest 72-hole score in tournament history, only trailing 2022 champion David Kocher who totaled 28-under 260
- First-round 10-under 62 matches the low start by a winner (others: 2018/Martin Trainer; 2011/Steve Friesen); second-round 10-under 62 ties the lowest Round 2 score in event history (others: 2015/Billy Mayfair; 2004/Chris Anderson)
- 54-hole total of 23-under 193 matched the 54-hole tournament scoring record at the Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Hiland Dairy Foods (other: 2015/Dawie van der Walt); broke the 36-hole tournament scoring record by four strokes with 20-under 124 (previous: 128/2015/Dawie van der Walt)

- Tied the second-lowest opening 36-hole score in Korn Ferry Tour history with 20-under 124, only trailing Stephan Jaeger/123/2016 Ellie Mae Classic
- 20-under par marked the lowest 36-hole score relative to par in consecutive rounds in Korn Ferry Tour history, breaking the previous record of 19-under par shared by four players (Johnny Keefer/2025 Astara Golf Championship presented by Mastercard/R2-R3, Matt McCarty/2024 Utah Championship presented by Zions Bank and Intermountain Health/R2-R3, Kevin Chappell/2010 Ford Wayne Gretzky Classic/R1-R2, Webb Simpson/2008 Chattanooga Classic/R1-R2)
- Marks third consecutive top-25 finish on Tour (T7/Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS; T12/The Ascendant presented by Blue) and ninth top-25 of the season
- Owns nine top-25 finishes in 15 starts this season, highlighted by his victory this week in addition to two top-10s (T9/Astara Chile Classic presented by Scotiabank; T7/Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS)
- Began the 2025 season with conditional status after a No. 84 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- En route to securing his best finish on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List, having previously finished No. 84 in 2024, No. 115 in 2022, and No. 95 in 2020
- Won the 2023 Totalplay Cup on PGA TOUR Latinoamérica (now PGA TOUR Americas) to secure fully exempt status on the Korn Ferry Tour in 2024; recorded five top-10 finishes, including two victories, en route to earning Player of the Year honors
- Played collegiately for four seasons at the University of West Florida (2014-18), winning an individual national title at the 2017 NCAA Division II Championships and the 2017 Division II Jack Nicklaus Award, presented to the top Division II golfer

Additional Notes

- Third-year member **Patrick Welch** (2nd/-24) earns his career-best finish on the Korn Ferry Tour (previous: T3/2023 Magnit Championship); 24-under 264 matches his career-low 72-hole score (other: 16-under 264/2023 Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Wichita Open/finished T12)
- Welch's runner-up finish improves his ranking to No. 42 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List; initially entered the week No. 127 and catapulted 85 spots up the Points List with his showing this week
- **Sudarshan Yellamaraju** (T3/-22), who won The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club, posts his best finish since his victory in the second event of the 2025 season; collects his third top-10 finish in 13 starts this season and improves to No. 14 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- The No. 2 finisher in the 2025 PGA TOUR University Ranking, **Brendan Valdes** (T3/-22), earns his first career top-10 finish in what is his fifth career start on the Korn Ferry Tour; leads the nine Class of 2025 PGA TOUR University alum on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List, improving to No. 84 after entering the week No. 153 on the Points List
- Korn Ferry Tour winner **Adrien Dumont de Chassart** (T5/-19) cards four consecutive rounds in the 60s to match his best finish of the season (other: T5/Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Wichita Open; the last time Dumont de Chassart notched multiple top-five finishes in a single season was as a rookie in 2023, when he secured his PGA TOUR card with a win at the BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX and a T2 at the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas Wichita Open)
- Class of 2023 Korn Ferry Tour graduate **Kevin Dougherty** (T7/-18) closes in 1-over 73 via three birdies against three double bogeys; posts back-to-back top-10 finishes, having matched his career-best finish with a runner-up showing at last week's The Ascendant presented by Blue
- Rookie **Neal Shipley** (T7/-18), who was searching for his third victory of the season this week to earn an immediate promotion to the PGA TOUR via the Three-Victory Promotion, closes in 1-over par 73 to post his fifth top-10 showing of the season
- Following three straight missed cuts, Class of 2023 Korn Ferry Tour graduate **Wilson Furr** (T7/-18), follows a T9 finish at last week's The Ascendant presented by Blue with a season-best T7 showing at the Price Cutter Charity Championship; improves to No. 63 on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Open qualifier **Harrison Ott** (T17/-16) collects his first career top-25 finish on the Korn Ferry Tour to earn himself a spot in next week's NV5 Invitational; Ott entered the week with no status on any PGA TOUR-sanctioned Tour, having lost his membership on PGA TOUR Americas following Segment I
