**Today** – Mostly cloudy in the morning with a slight chance of an isolated shower/t-storm. Expect more sun this afternoon with a slightly higher chance of a few pop-up showers/t-storms developing, highest chance between 2-6pm. Any t-storms that do develop will be capable of locally heavy rainfall. Winds will be light, generally from the south/southwest. Highs reach near 88F. Peak Heat Index: 95-100F.

Observed rainfall last 24 hours 0.73". Rainfall today: 0.10-0.25", locally 0.50" with storms.
