**Christo Lamprecht (T1/-11)**

- Poised to hold the first 36-hole lead/co-lead of his Korn Ferry Tour career in what is his 12th start on Tour; previous best 36-hole position was T3 at the 2024 Ascendant presented by Blue
- Cards a bogey-free 7-under 65 in the second round and records the lowest 36-hole score of his Korn Ferry Tour career with an 11-under 133 (previously; 10-under/134/2024 Ascendant)
- Making first career start at The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club
- Finished T45 in the season opener at The Bahamas Golf Classic at Atlantis Paradise Island last week
- Made 10 starts during the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour season with three made cuts, including a T5 finish at The Ascendant
- Earned guaranteed starts in the first 12 events of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season with a T19 finish at Final Stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Owns five career starts on the PGA TOUR, including the 2023 Open Championship (T74) and 2024 Masters Tournament (MC); best finish came at the 2024 Butterfield Bermuda Championship (T23)
- Finished No. 2 in the 2024 PGA TOUR University Ranking after four seasons at Georgia Tech (2021-24), earning Korn Ferry Tour membership for the remainder of the 2024 season

- Captured two collegiate victories, garnering three All-America honors (First Team in 2023 and 2024, Third Team in 2022) and three All-Atlantic Coast Conference selections (2022, 2023, 2024), along with the 2024 ACC Player of the Year award
- Won The 128th Amateur Championship at Hillside Golf Club in England, defeating Switzerland's Ronan Kleu 3 and 2 in the championship match
- Reached No. 1 in World Amateur Golf Ranking for the first time in September 2023, becoming the first South African to reach No. 1. Held the No. 1 ranking for a total of 22 weeks prior to turning professional in June 2024
- A George, South Africa native

#### **Davis Chatfield (T1/-11)**

- Matches his career-low round with a bogey-free 9-under 63 (R2/2023 Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron)
- Makes second career cut at The Bahamas Great Abaco classic in what is his third start in the event; finished T11 at last season's tournament
- Positioned to hold second 36-hole lead/co-lead of his career (2023 Compliance Solutions Championship/finished T17)
- Logs his 41st career made cut in what is his 51st start on Tour
- Earned fully exempt status for the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season with a No. 44 finish on the 2024 Korn Ferry Tour Points List
- Made 21 cuts in 24 starts last season with six top-25 finishes and two top-10s; best finish came in the form of a T3 at the NV5 Invitational
- Finished No. 62 on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List as a rookie to earn fully exempt status for the 2024 season
- Played five seasons at the University of Notre Dame (2017-22), earning a 2022 All-Atlantic Coast Conference Team selection as a fifth-year senior
- Attleboro, Massachusetts native

#### **Additional Player Notes**

- Second-year member **Austin Hitt** (T3/-10), who finished T11 at last season's The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club, cards a bogey-free 7-under 65; highlighted by eagles on the par-5 14th and 18th
- Korn Ferry Tour rookie **Brandon Berry** (T3/-10), who earned guaranteed starts in the first eight events of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season with a T43 finish at Final Stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School, holds the best 36-hole position of his career in a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event (previously; T55/2024 Corales Puntacana Championship/finished 65th)
- 2023 Korn Ferry Tour graduate **Tom Whitney** (T3/-10), who finished T3 at this event during the 2023 campaign, posts a bogey-free 4-under 68 and stands inside the top five after 36 holes for the first time on Tour since the 2023 The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic
- **Seungtaek Lee** (T7/-9), who is making his second career start on Tour this week, records a career-low bogey-free 7-under 65, featuring five birdies (Nos. 1, 6, 7, 12, 18) and an eagle on the par-5 eighth
  - Secured guaranteed starts in the first 12 events of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season via a T14 finish at Final Stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School
- First-round leader **Luke Guthrie** (T21/-7) cards an even par 72 in the second round
