Today – Sunny skies early will give way to a gradual increase in clouds through this afternoon. A few tshowers are expected to develop after 3pm as a small upper level disturbance combines with heating of the day. Temperatures will warm into the mid-70s this afternoon with winds generally W with peak gusts around 25 mph at times.

Tomorrow – Mostly sunny skies are expected tomorrow morning with another gradual increase in cloud cover through the afternoon. Yet another small upper level disturbance currently sitting over South Dakota will rapidly move towards the southeast into tomorrow. By tomorrow afternoon/evening a slight chance of tshowers could develop as the disturbance interacts with heating of the day. Greater chances will exist to the south and to the west of the area. Temperatures starting out in the 50s will warm into the mid to upper 70s. Generally light and variable winds are expected to trend W/WSW peaking around 5-10 mph briefly during the afternoon. **Potential Rainfall: < 0.10"**
