Extended Forecast – A wave of severe tstorms is expected tomorrow afternoon into the evening. All hazards are possible with damaging wind gusts along the leading edge of the storms, areas of hail, and possibly a tornado. A slight chance of showers will hold on the back side of the system on Saturday with dry and hazard free conditions expected Sunday into early next week. Overnight temperatures will be in the upper 50s to mid-60s with daytime highs in the upper 70s to 80F. The strongest winds of the period are expected on Saturday afternoon when W gusts around 20 mph will be possible.
