Extended Forecast – Dry conditions expected Friday and most of Saturday, but a very low chance remains for a shower after 5pm Saturday. Sunday continues to look like the most active day of the weekend. There has been more variability in the guidance over the last 24 hours, but rain showers are possible in the morning with lightning chances picking up around midday. However, there is a chance now that we end up mostly dry in the morning with any rain holding off until the afternoon. Will need to continue watching closely. Upwards of 0.40-0.50" possible during the day. Temps will cool to well below normal with highs in the 70s much of the weekend, with lows Friday and Saturday morning still dropping to near 50F.
