MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

Medical Extension storylines

Brandon Matthews is making his final start on his Korn Ferry Tour Medical Extension and needs 157.530 FedExCup points (2-way T3 or better) to maintain status on the PGA TOUR. He can only reach his top-125 number with a win. A runner-up, solo-third or 2-way T3 would move him to the reorder category for the remainder of the season. Should he not reach this threshold, he would no longer have membership on TOUR (has membership on the Korn Ferry Tour).

TOP 50 RETENTION TRACKING

28 of the top 50 players in the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the top 50 of the current season's standings through The Open Championship. At No. 6, Harris English is the highest in the FedExCup standings among players that were outside the top 50 in 2024 (No. 55 in 2024).

ELIGIBILITY NOTES

FedExCup Playoffs

The top 70 players in the FedExCup standings through next week's Wyndham Championship will qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs, which begin the following week at the FedEx St. Jude Championship. Players who qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs will secure their card for the 2026 season.

As a reminder, exempt status was changed from top 125 to top 100 in the FedExCup standings through the FedExCup Fall, with conditional status for finishers 101-125. This change was incorporated for players who receive their cards via the Korn Ferry Tour/DP World Tour/Q-School to have a greater certainty of schedule and equitable playing opportunities for Full-Field Events.
