Adam Svensson (1st/-11)

- Bogey-free 11-under 60 sets the 3M Open scoring record by two strokes (62/most recent: Beau Hossler/R4/2023)
- Equals his low 18-hole score on the PGA TOUR (2024 Bank of Utah Championship/R1/finished T25)
- Second Canadian on TOUR to shoot 60 or better multiple times in the last 42 years (Mackenzie Hughes)
- Second-lowest round on TOUR this season (59/Jake Knapp/R1/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- Gained 4.89 strokes putting, his most in a round on TOUR; led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting in round one
- Made a career-best 194' 2" of putts (previous: 169' 2" at the 2021 RSM Classic/R2)
- Matches his most birdies or better in a round on TOUR with 10 (2024 Bank of Utah Championship/R1)
- Fourth 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-3 to date converting to victory
 - 2019 Sony Open in Hawaii/finished T43
 - o 2022 ISCO Championship/finished 6th
 - 2024 Bank of Utah Championship/finished T25
- Making fifth start at the 3M Open (T15/2019, MC/2022, T37/2023, T37/2024)
- Earned lone PGA TOUR victory at the 2022 RSM Classic
- Best finish on TOUR this season: T24/Corales Puntacana Championship; last top-10: T7/2024 Wyndham Championship.
- Enters the week at No. 170 in the FedExCup standings and playing on the final year of his Tournament Winners exemption

Miscellaneous notes:

- Sam Stevens (T2/-9) posts his career-low 9-under 62 (previous: 63/2024 Sony Open in Hawaii/R3); two top-10s this season, highlighted by a runner-up at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Eight-time DP World Tour winner **Thorbjørn Olesen** (T2/-9) records his second round of 62 or better on TOUR this season (61/RBC Canadian Open/R1); 10 birdies ties his most in a round on TOUR (2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic/61/R4)
- Chris Gotterup (T4/-8) opens with a bogey-free 8-under 63, his fourth bogey-free round on TOUR this season; has finished inside the top 25 in 11 of his 23 events played this season, highlighted by his second PGA TOUR victory at the Genesis Scottish Open and solo-third finish at last week's Open Championship
- Making his fourth PGA TOUR start and second this season (T41/John Deere Classic), **Brendan Valdes** (T7/-7) records the lowest nine-hole score in 3M Open history with a 7-under 28 on the front nine (his back nine), which ties the lowest nine-hole score on TOUR this season (Jesper Svensson/Texas Children's Houston Open/R3); Auburn product finished No. 2 in the final 2025 PGA TOUR University Ranking and is exempt on the Korn Ferry Tour for the remainder of the season as well as Final Stage of PGA TOUR Q-School presented by Korn Ferry
- Making his third start at the 3M Open and first since 2020, **Max Homa** (T18/-5) hit 18 of 18 Greens in Regulation for the first time in his career; enters the week No. 102 in the FedExCup and has one top-10 in 18 starts this season (T5/John Deere Classic)

- Past champions in the field: Lee Hodges (T53/-3), Jhonattan Vegas (T53/-3), Cameron Champ (T77/-2), Tony Finau (T77/-2)
- Philip Knowles (neck) withdrew prior to his first round and was replaced in field by Ryan Brehm (T114/E)
