Thorbjørn Olesen (1st/-14)

- In his tournament debut, posts 128 for his career-low 36-hole score on TOUR (previous: 131/2025 RBC Canadian Open/finished T36)
- First 36-hole lead/co-lead in his 95th career start on TOUR
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (6.526) through two rounds; picked up 4.313 strokes in round two, the most in a round in his career (previous: 3.72/2018 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational/R3)
- Enters the week No. 129 in the FedExCup with two top-10s in 16 starts this season (T5/Valero Texas Open, T7/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic)
- Seeks to become the first player from Denmark to win on the PGA TOUR; one of four PGA TOUR members from Denmark this season (others: Nicolai Højgaard, Rasmus Højgaard, Niklas Norgaard)
- Best career finish on TOUR: T3/2018 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational
- Eight-time DP World Tour winner earned PGA TOUR membership for the 2025 season after finishing No. 7 in the 2024 DP World Tour Top 10, which awards TOUR membership to the top 10 finishers in the final Race to Dubai Rankings, not otherwise exempt; also earned TOUR membership for the 2024 season via the DP World Tour Top 10 before finishing No. 170 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings

Miscellaneous notes:

- Jake Knapp (2nd/-13) is bogey free through 36 holes for the first time in his TOUR career; leads the field in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (3.831) and Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (8.400) through two rounds
- Playing the 2025 season with conditional status (126-150 in 2024 FedExCup Fall standings), Pierceson Coody (T3/-12) opens with 65-65 in his second appearance at the 3M Open (72nd/2024); one top-20 finish in 10 starts this season (T16/Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Sam Stevens (T3/-12) ranks second and third in Strokes Gained: Around the Green (2.726) and Strokes Gained: Putting (4.983), respectively, through two rounds; enters the week No. 44 in the FedExCup with two top-10 finishes this season including his second career runner-up at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Entering the week No. 77 in the FedExCup, six-time TOUR winner **Chris Kirk** (T5/-11) is making his third tournament appearance and first since 2021; lone top-10 finish in 19 starts this season is a T2 at the Rocket Classic where he fell in a playoff
- Japan's **Takumi Kanaya** (T5/-11) posts bogey-free 64, his low score in 53 rounds this season; enters the week No. 150 in the FedExCup with one top-10 in 20 starts this season (T5/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- Alex Noren (T8/-10) posts 9-under 62 for the low round of the day with bogeys on his first and final holes of the round
