Today – Dry conditions are forecast this morning under mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies. A stray pop-up shower or thunderstorm cannot be ruled out late this afternoon, otherwise expect dry and breezy conditions for the conclusion of the 3M Open. Southerly winds will become sustained at 10-16 mph this afternoon along with gusts in the 18-22 mph range. The temperature will reach a high in the low 90s while the heat index will be in the upper 90s to low 100s throughout the afternoon.

Tonight and Monday – A few vicinity thunderstorms may develop this evening, with more widespread heavy rain and thunderstorms expected to arrive between 10pm and midnight tonight. This activity will persist into early Monday morning before diminishing prior to daybreak Monday. A few strong to severe thunderstorms are possible overnight, with damaging wind gusts and hail being the primary concerns.

Forecast rainfall 7pm Sunday to 7am Monday: 0.50" – 1.00" with locally higher totals near 2" possible.
