Extended forecast – Light winds and mostly clear skies overnight may allow for patches of fog to develop Friday morning. Any reduction to visibility will improve between 7-8am Friday morning. Otherwise expect increasing clouds Friday afternoon with a high in the mid 80s with light southeasterly winds. A weak disturbance may kick off an isolated coverage of showers and thunderstorms Saturday morning, with a few additional pop-up thunderstorms possible Saturday afternoon. Sunday will start off dry with isolated pop-up thunderstorms becoming possible after 1pm. Likely chances for rain and storms will return overnight Sunday into early Monday morning.
