## Russell Henley (Won/-11)

- Fifth career PGA TOUR title at the age of 35 years, 10 months, 25 days
- **PGA TOUR wins (5):** 2013 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2014 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2017 Texas Children's Houston Open, 2022 World Wide Technology Championship
- Final-round 70 included a chip-in for eagle at the 16<sup>th</sup> hole to close with a back-nine 33; second winner of the Arnold Palmer Invitational since 1983 to eagle the 16<sup>th</sup> hole during the final round and first since Marc Leishman (2017)
- First victory in 47 starts on TOUR (2022 World Wide Technology Championship); posted 14 top-10 finishes between victories
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Around the Green (6.382)
- Fourth top-10 finish in six starts this season, the most of any player on TOUR
- Entered the week with 10 top-10 finishes since 2024, tied for the most on TOUR without a victory (Sungjae Im)
- Entered the week with one top-10 finish in eight career appearances at the Arnold Palmer Invitational (T4/2024)
- Earns 700 FedExCup points and moves from No. 17 to No. 2 in the FedExCup standings, his highest position since the 2013 American Express (2<sup>nd</sup>)
- Projected to move from No. 14 to No. 7 in the Official World Golf Ranking, his career-high rank (previous: No. 12/2024
   Open Championship) and first time inside the top 10

## **Miscellaneous Notes**

- 54-hole leader **Collin Morikawa** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-10) collects his 11<sup>th</sup> career runner-up finish and fourth since the start of the 2024 season, the most of any player on TOUR; marks his second runner-up this season (The Sentry)
- Corey Conners (3<sup>rd</sup>/-9) posted the only bogey-free final round (1 birdie, 17 pars) for a 71; fifth consecutive top-25 finish at the Arnold Palmer Invitational and matches his solo-third finish in 2021; qualified for the 153<sup>rd</sup> Open at Royal Portrush through the Open Qualifying Series as the top finisher not otherwise exempt
- After qualifying through the Aon Next 10, Michael Kim (4<sup>th</sup>/-8) posts his second top-10 in as many weeks and third of the season (T2/WM Phoenix Open, T6/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- **Keegan Bradley** (T5/-7) posts 64 to tie his career-low score in 54 rounds at the Arnold Palmer Invitational (R3/2021); front-nine 29 is the lowest front-nine score at Bay Hill since 1983
- **Sepp Straka** (T5/-7) reclaimed the FedExCup standings lead with his third top-10 finish in eight starts this season; previously held the No. 1 spot for two weeks (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, WM Phoenix Open)
