Today – High pressure building into Florida will provide one more breezy day. NW to WNW winds of 14-18 gusting near 30 mph this morning will gradually decrease this afternoon down to 10-15 gusting to 20 mph by late in the day. Otherwise, drier and cooler air has overspread the state with highs only reaching the upper 60s this afternoon despite sunny skies. The breeze will make it feel cooler at times as well. **Sunrise: 6:44am / Sunset: 6:28pm**

Extended forecast – A chilly start can be expected Friday morning with temperatures in the upper 40s. This will bring the chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms to the region late Sunday night into Monday morning before the front moves to the east.
