MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

SIGNATURE EVENTS

Field composition

The field for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am is made up of 80 players using the following eligibility criteria:

- Top 50 in the 2024 FedExCup standings
- Aon Next 10 (Nos. 51-60 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings)
- Top finisher from the 2024 Race to Dubai, not otherwise exempt
- Aon Swing 5 (top FedExCup points earners in the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open, not otherwise exempt)
- Current-year tournament winners
- PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Four sponsor exemptions restricted to PGA TOUR members
- If necessary to fill the field to 80 players, next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10 standings

No players are exempt out of the current-year tournament winner and top 30 OWGR categories, as all winners this season and all PGA TOUR members in the top 30 are exempt through a higher category.

Filling the field

The AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am fills the field to 80 players due to the pro-am format using the next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10 standings (beyond No. 60 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings). New in 2025, the six remaining Signature Events will fill the field to 72 players, if necessary, using the next available players from the Aon Next 10 standings.

Last man in the field

The last man in the field is Keith Mitchell, No. 75 in the FedExCup Fall standings. 12 players got into the field from the "fill the field" category (nine in 2024).

Players in the field who are exempt for The Genesis Invitational

- 59 of the 80 players in the field are exempt for The Genesis Invitational
- 48 of the top 50 from the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the field (Xander Schauffele and Alex Noren are not playing this week)
 - Players from the Aon Next 10 (Nos. 51-60 from the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings)
 - Top finisher from the 2024 Race to Dubai, not otherwise exempt (Rasmus Højgaard)

Players can play their way into The Genesis Invitational or receive a spot through:

- Aon Swing 5 (will use the current standings combined with points earned at the WM Phoenix Open)
- Sponsor exemptions (four, restricted to PGA TOUR members)
- Winners of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and WM Phoenix Open, if not otherwise exempt
- PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the Official World Golf Ranking through WM Phoenix Open
- If necessary to fill the field to 72 players, beyond No. 10 the Aon Next 10 standings

Players in the field who are exempt for the remaining Signature Events

- 50 of the 80 players in the field are exempt for all six remaining Signature Events
- 48 of the top 50 from the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the field (Xander Schauffele and Alex Noren are not playing this week)
 - Nick Taylor (won Sony Open in Hawaii) and Harris English (won Farmers Insurance Open)
