SIGNATURE EVENT FACT SHEET (AT&T PEBBLE BEACH PRO-AM)

OVERVIEW

Signature Events are limited-field events comprised of the top PGA TOUR players from the previous season's FedExCup as well as trending players from the current season who play their way in via the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5. These eligibility pathways deliver compelling storylines and added consequence at Full Field Events while impacting the season-long race for the FedExCup.

AON NEXT 10 and AON SWING 5

The Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 are eligibility pathways for players, not already qualified, to play their way into Signature Events via the FedExCup standings.





- Aon Next 10: Top 10 available players, not otherwise exempt, from FedExCup standings. The Aon Next 10 will always fill to 10 players. (Note: the Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the FedExCup Fall standings. For each Signature Event after, the Aon Next 10 will include the top 10 players from the current FedExCup standings, not otherwise exempt, through the week prior)
- Aon Swing 5: Top five available players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points from events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Swing 5 will always fill to five players.

STORYLINES

The AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am is the second Signature Event of the 2025 PGA TOUR Season and the first for which players qualified via the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5. The Aon Next 10 was determined through the FedExCup Fall standings (Nos. 51-60), while the top five players not otherwise exempt who earned the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open qualified through the Aon Swing 5. Points earned during the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am do not count towards the Aon Swing 5 for The Genesis Invitational (Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open, WM Phoenix Open), while the Aon Next 10 will be the same for The Genesis Invitational.

LAST WEEK ON TOUR: Farmers Insurance Open

Harris English earned his fifth career victory on TOUR. English was already exempt for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational via the Aon Next 10 (FedExCup Fall Nos. 51-60). Three players logged top-10 finishes to move inside the Aon Swing 5 and earn a start in this week's AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am: Sam Stevens (2nd), Andrew Novak (3rd), Lee Hodges (T9).

PLAYERS TO WATCH: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am

Nick Taylor finished No. 60 in the FedExCup Fall standings to earn a start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am through the Aon Next 10. Taylor, a five-time PGA TOUR winner, won the 2020 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am by four strokes in wire-to-wire fashion for his second career victory.

Maverick McNealy, the leading player from the Aon Next 10, will be making his seventh appearance at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and first since becoming a PGA TOUR winner at the 2024 RSM Classic. In his past six starts at the event, McNealy has four made cuts and a pair of top-five finishes (2nd/2021, T5/2020).

J.J. Spaun qualified through the Aon Swing 5 standings after logging two finishes inside the top 15 in his last three starts (T3/The American Express, T15/ Farmers Insurance Open). This will mark Spaun's seventh career start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (best finish: T16/2022).

SIGNATURE EVENTS ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility criteria for Signature Events (outside The Sentry):

- Top 50 in the previous season's FedExCup standings
- Aon Next 10
- Aon Swing 5
- If not exempt from a higher category listed above: current-vear tournament winners (excluding Additional Events) and PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the OWGR
- Four sponsor exemptions (PGA TOUR members)
- The three player-hosted events each have one tournament host exemption, which is not restricted to PGA TOUR members

- · Field sizes for Signature Events are approximately 70-80 players (80 players for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am due to format). New in 2025, fields will have a minimum of 72 players. If necessary to fill the field, tournaments will use the next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10.
