Rory McIlroy (T2/-15)

- World No. 3 and three-time FedExCup champion posts a bogey-free 7-under 65
- Seeks to win in his season debut for the third time in his career, with both coming in THE CJ CUP (2021, 2022)
- Leads the field with 26 victories (T22 all time), most recently at the 2024 Truist Championship
- Third appearance at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (MC/2018, T66/2024)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (3.830) and Driving Distance (337.8)
