

Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Wyndham Clark earned 700 FedExCup points and his third PGA TOUR win at the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. Clark moved to third in the FedExCup standings marking his ninth week inside the Top-3 of the FedExCup in his PGA TOUR Career.
