Today – An upper-level low-pressure system is moving across the area early this morning and will continue to move east as we go through the day. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will be possible through mid to late morning before the precipitation shifts east of St. George. Improving conditions can be expected through the afternoon with partly cloudy skies becoming mostly sunny. Temperatures will be slightly cooler today with highs in the mid-70s.
